WHAT IS FIFA TMS AND WHY DO I NEED IT?

FIFA's Transfer Matching System (FIFA TMS) is the online platform created by FIFA to monitor, record and process all international and domestic transfers for amateur and professional football players.

Any player registering as a professional OR an amateur in Australia whose most recent registration was with an overseas club will require an International Transfer Certificate (ITC) processed through FIFA TMS.

Any player registering as a professional in Australia whose most recent registration was with a different Australian club, as a professional or an amateur, will require a Domestic Transfer Certificate (DTC) processed through FIFA TMS. There are no DTCs required for players registering as amateurs.

Clubs will need to contact Football Australia (FA) to request a user account which will be set up by FIFA. They will need to submit any professional ITCs and professional DTCs into FIFA TMS using their club user account.

Clubs will need to send applications for Amateur ITCs to their relevant Member Federation (MF) for these to be approved and sent to FA for processing.

Transfer Process Overview



1. Player submits registration on Play Football

Please refer to the Play Football hub for information and guidance on the registration process in Play Football

2. Player is flagged in Play Football as requiring a DTC or ITC

Clubs should also understand when a DTC or ITC is required, without having to rely on Play Football to flag it in the registration process

3. Club submits transfer in TMS

If Clubs know a player requires a DTC or ITC, they should submit the transfer as soon as practicable. This may even occur before Step 1 or concurrently with Step 1.

4. FA completes ITC or DTC in TMS

Once the relevant confirmation and approval steps are completed by the corresponding parties, FA will complete the transfer process in TMS and download the international or domestic transfer certificate.

5. FA approves player's registration in Play Football

The completion of the transfer process in TMS does not automatically flow into Play Football. FA staff will need to separately approve the player's registration in Play Football.

6. Player can finalise registration process

Once FA has approved the player's registration, the player can finalise the registration process on their end, including making payment.

HOW TO REQUEST A FIFA TMS CLUB USER ACCOUNT



- If a club requires a FIFA TMS user account, please email the following details to dtmssupport@footballaustralia.com.au:
 1. User's full name;
 2. User's title/role at the club;
 3. User's email address (FIFA does not allow shared club inboxes to be used as log-ins); and
 4. A copy of the user's passport or another form of government issued ID.

PROFESSIONAL ITCS AND DTCS



PROFESSIONAL ITCS

WHAT IS A PROFESSIONAL ITC AND WHEN DO YOU NEED ONE?

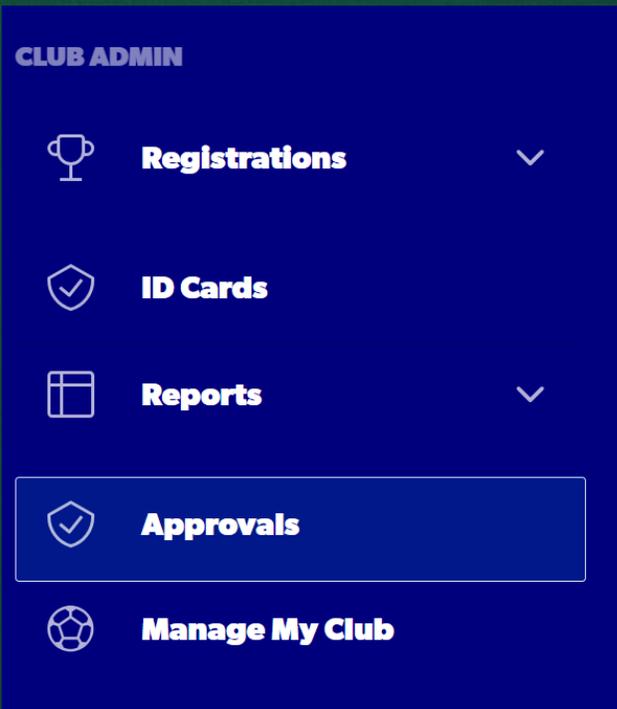
Any player registering as a professional in Australia whose most recent registration was with an overseas club will require an International Transfer Certificate (ITC) processed through FIFA TMS.

All professional ITCs must be submitted by the relevant club AND requested by FA **within** a professional registration window. Please note that a club can submit an ITC into TMS before the registration window opens however, FA can only request these ITCs once registration window opens.

It is important to remember that the ITC process through TMS is managed by FIFA and this comes before any other registration processes. If a player that requires a professional ITC has registered in Play Football during the window, however, the ITC was not submitted into TMS by the club or was submitted incorrectly, FIFA will consider this registration as being outside the registration window and will not allow it to be completed.

STEP 1

PLAY FOOTBALL REGISTRATION



The first step in the ITC process is having the player register in Play Football.

Once the player has registered in Play Football, their registration will be flagged as needing an ITC.

The player's registration status will update to 'ITC PENDING'

Once this registration is entered into the system, a ticket will appear in the 'Approvals' tab for the club to action. This is when the club will need to log into TMS and submit the ITC.

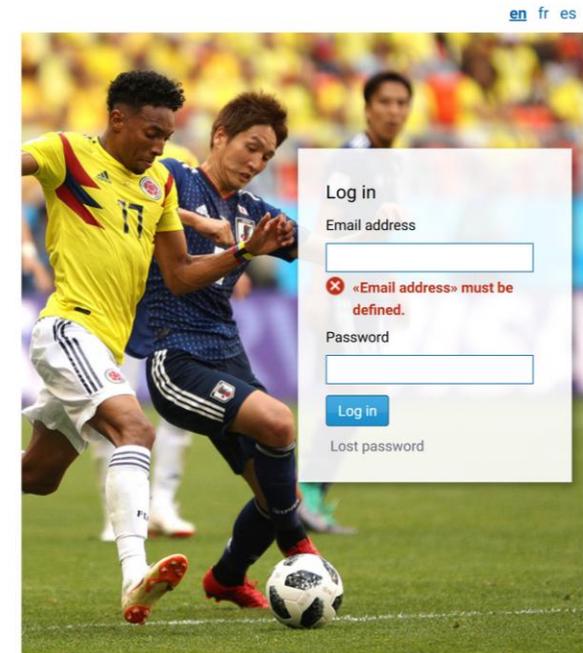

Find the 'TRANSFERS' tab at the top of the TMS home page. When you hover over the tab it will bring up the drop-down menu. Please select 'OVERVIEW' from these options.

THE TRANSFER OVERVIEW PAGE



The Transfer Overview page in TMS will provide the club with updates on all pending transfers. You will be able to see the progress of the ITC in the 'Status' Column. See the next slide for an example of this page.

The status messages you will see are:

Pending

If an ITC has the status 'Pending', this means you have not successfully submitted the ITC, and it is sitting in draft. To fix this status, you will need to select 'edit', scroll to the bottom of the transfer page and select 'Confirm Transfer'. While an ITC is in 'Pending', FA is unable to request the ITC and FIFA considers these ITCs as having not been submitted. If an ITC is left in 'Pending', FIFA will not allow it to be requested outside the registration window.

Awaiting Confirmation of Player

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting Confirmation of Player', this means that the player did not exist in the FIFA TMS system and must be confirmed by the player's previous country.

Awaiting ITC Request

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting ITC Request', this means it has been submitted and is sitting with FA to send the request to the player's previous country.

Awaiting ITC Delivery

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting ITC Delivery', this means the ITC has been requested by FA and is waiting for the previous country to deliver the ITC to FA.

Awaiting Registration Confirmation

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting Registration Confirmation', this means the ITC has been delivered by the previous country and is sitting with FA to complete.

Awaiting Counter Instruction

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting Counter Instruction', this means that you have submitted the transfer as a loan or have included a transfer agreement in the ITC. In these cases, the ITC must be confirmed by the previous club prior to the ITC coming to FA to request.

STEP 4

START THE ITC SUBMISSION

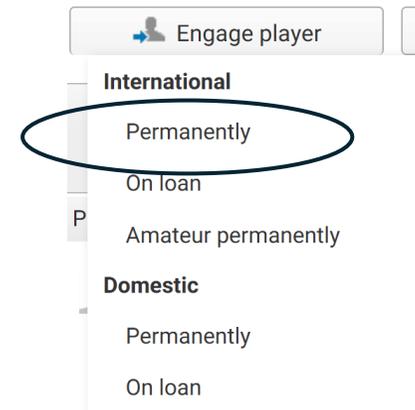
IMPORTANT!

If you select the wrong type of transfer (e.g. 'On Loan', 'Amateur Permanently' or one of the Domestic options), FIFA will not consider this as a submission. If this occurs in a registration window and results in a new ITC needing to be submitted outside the registration window, FIFA will not allow it to be approved.

To start an ITC submission, once you have navigated to the Transfer Overview page of TMS, you will need to find the 'Engage Player' option at the top the screen and select it.



This will bring up a drop-down menu. For a professional ITC, you will need to select 'International – Permanently'. This will take you to the ITC submission page of TMS.

STEP 5

SEARCH FOR THE PLAYER

The first step when you are on the ITC submission page will be to find or create the player in the system that requires an ITC.

STEP 5

SEARCH FOR THE PLAYER

IMPORTANT!

The only type of photo ID that FIFA accepts for ITCs is the player's passport. This must be uploaded as a PDF.

If you cannot find the player's FIFA profile, please select 'Extended Search'. Please fill in the player's details into the extended search section and select 'Search Player'.

Please select this option if the player's previous contract has expired. If you select this option, TMS will ask you to put in the 'Date of Expiry' and upload 'Proof of last contract end date'. The 'Date of Expiry' must match the document that is uploaded. You can upload the player's previous contract or confirmation, usually in the form of a letter, from the previous club.

For a player that has unilaterally terminated their former contract, TMS will ask for proof of the termination. You will need to upload signed proof of the player's unilateral termination including documentation from an authority recognising the unilateral termination e.g. a union or lawyer.

STEP 7

THE FORMER CLUB

IMPORTANT!

If you cannot find the club and the only options that are appearing are all Australian Clubs (and have FFA, Australia in the country section), please check that you have not submitted the transfer as a domestic transfer. Australian clubs will only show up in this section for domestic transfers.

In-between the transfer agreement and player status questions, TMS will need you to input the player's previous club.

If you cannot find the previous club, TMS will give you an option to 'Create Club'. Please select 'Create Club', fill in the club name and association and this will allow FA to request the ITC and the previous country to select the correct club. If the club is incorrect the other country may cancel the ITC and ask you to submit a new transfer with the correct club. FIFA will allow this to be completed outside the registration window if required as long as the initial ITC request was submitted within the registration window.

For all professional ITCs, you will need to upload the player's new contract details into the ITC submission. At the bottom of this section, you will be asked to upload a copy of the player's new contract to the submission. The details that you input into these answers must match the contract that is uploaded exactly or FIFA will not allow the ITC to be approved.

The employment contract 'Start' and 'End' dates must match the 'Term' section of the new contract exactly. If the contract has anything other than a date in this section (e.g. Round 1 or 30 days after last match) please put in dates that are as close as possible.

The player's basic salary must also match the contract exactly. If the player is on match payments and not a salary, please select weekly for the frequency.

Please select AUD for the currency.

Please input the amount that matches the frequency that you have submitted.

If the player is on match payments, or is paid on a win, draw, loss system, please input the lowest option that isn't \$0.

Example:

Player A is on match payments and is paid \$400 for a win, \$300 for a draw and \$200 for a loss.

The TMS transfer would state that the player was being paid \$200 weekly from the contract start date to the contract end date.

If the player is on a multi year contract where the payments change for future years, you are able to select 'Add Salary Period' and input each year separately.

You can select 'yes' to this question and fill in the details. If there are more than one payment, you can select 'Add Payment' and input each payment separately.

The 'Total fixed remuneration' will be automatically calculated based off your answers to the previous salary questions.

Please note that this total may be different to the actual total that the player is paid and does not require you to pay this amount.

You will need to select whether you or the player has engaged a Football Agent for representation as part of the ITC process.



When this is checked, FIFA will be looking to see if a Football Agent has signed the player's new professional contract. If a Football Agent has signed the contract that is uploaded and has not been declared in the ITC submission, FIFA will not allow the ITC to be approved.

If a Football Agent has signed the contract, you will need to select 'Yes' to the club question (if the club engaged the Football Agent) or the player question (if the player engaged the Football Agent).

In both cases, you will need to search the name of the agent. The agent will only appear if they are certified by FIFA allowing them to act as an agent for football players and clubs.

For clubs, you will also need to add the Football Agent service fee and club representation agreement. If there are multiple Football Agents for the player or the club, you can select 'Add Football Agent' and add them separately.

STEP 10

PAYMENTS & TPO



The last section of the transfer submission is the Payments & TPO section.

Is this transfer made against Release(buy-out) fee?

Please select only select 'Yes' to this question if you have paid a fee to release the player from their previous contract. If this has not occurred, please select 'No'.

Please read and answer the Declarations carefully.

Training rewards waiver

This section is optional. It is important to note that all clubs in Australia, with the exception of clubs participating in the A-Leagues, are considered by FIFA as category 4 clubs and, as a result, do not need to pay training compensation.

NPL clubs can leave this section blank. If you have any questions about training compensation, please contact FA.

STEP 11

FINAL SUBMISSION

IMPORTANT!

If you save the ITC as a draft but select 'View details' from the transfer over page and not 'Edit', you will be able to view the transfer but will not be able to confirm it or make any changes.



The last step in is to confirm the transfer.

Please note that, once you have submitted the transfer, FIFA does not allow it to be edited. You are able to submit additional documents to the transfer, however, if you have made any errors, you will need to cancel the submission and create a new one from scratch.

Once you have selected the player profile at the beginning, this will allow you to 'Save as Draft'. This will place the ITC in the 'Pending' status and will allow you to select 'Edit' from the transfer overview page to continue editing and make any changes. Please remember that you will need to go back into the ITC to 'Confirm Transfer' for it to progress to the next stage.

If you are ready to submit the ITC, please select the tick-box declaring the information is correct and select 'Confirm Transfer'.

THE NEXT STEPS



Club submits ITC into TMS as per this guide.



If the club had to create the player, the ITC will be sent to the previous country to confirm that player's registration history.

If the player's FIFA profile was found when submitting the ITC, the ITC will skip this step.



FA will check and request the ITC from the previous association.

This step must be completed within the professional registration window for FIFA to allow the ITC to be completed.



The previous country has 72 hours from midnight on the day of the ITC request to deliver or cancel the ITC.



Once the ITC is delivered by the previous country, FA will complete the ITC in TMS and approve the player in Play Football. The club will get an automatic email from Play Football notifying them of this, allowing for the payment and approval of the registration.

PROFESSIONAL DTCS

WHAT IS A PROFESSIONAL DTC AND WHEN DO YOU NEED ONE?

Any player registering as a professional in Australia whose most recent registration was with a different club in Australia will require a Domestic Transfer Certificate (DTC) processed through FIFA TMS.

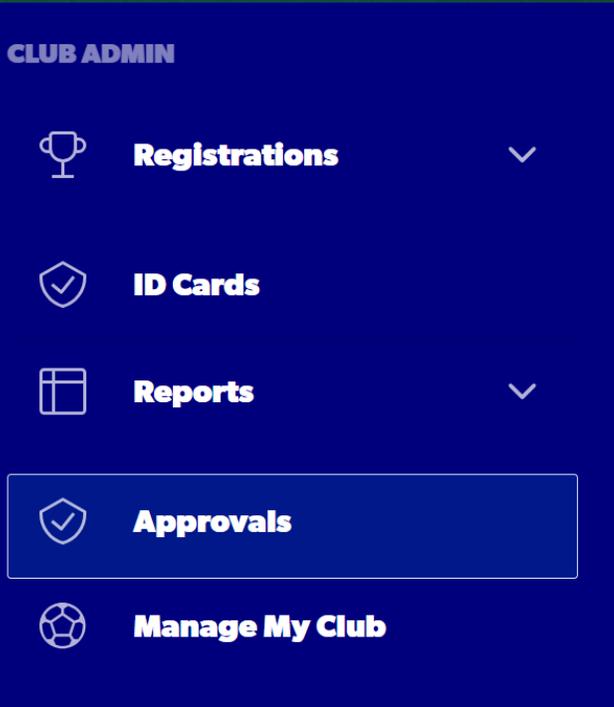
It doesn't matter if they previously played as an amateur or a professional. If the player is moving to a new club and is registering as a professional, they will require a DTC.

The only situations where a player does not need a DTC is if the player was previously as a professional with your club and is re-registering, is being promoted from within the club (e.g. their most recent registration was with your club as an amateur) or if the player is registering with your club as an amateur.

All professional DTCs must be submitted by the relevant club within a professional registration window.

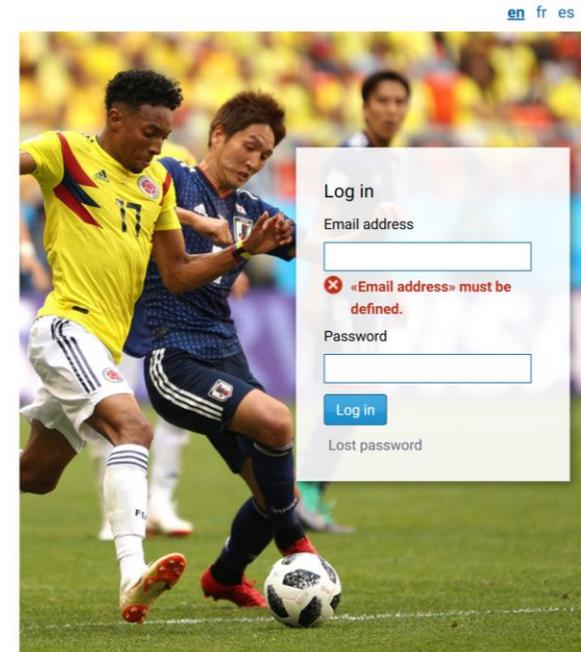

If an DTC has the status 'Awaiting Confirmation of Player', this means that the player did not exist in the FIFA TMS system and must be confirmed by FA.

Awaiting Transfer Approval

If an DTC has the status 'Awaiting Transfer Approval', this means it has been submitted and is sitting with your Member Federation to approve in TMS.

Awaiting Registration Confirmation

If an ITC has the status 'Awaiting Registration Confirmation', this means the DTC has been approved by your Member Federation and is sitting with FA to complete.

Awaiting Counter Instruction

If an DTC has the status 'Awaiting Counter Instruction', this means that you have submitted the transfer as a loan or have included a transfer agreement in the DTC. In these cases, the DTC must be confirmed by the previous club prior to the DTC coming to your Member Federation to approve and FA to complete.

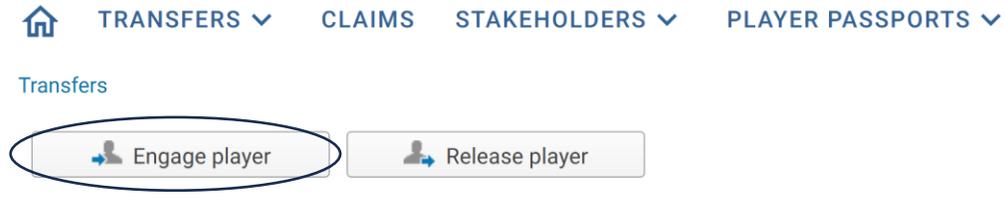

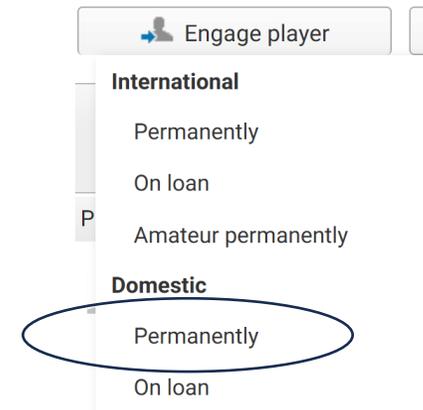

To start a DTC submission, once you have navigated to the Transfer Overview page of TMS, you will need to find the 'Engage Player' option at the top the screen and select it.



This will bring up a drop-down menu. For a DTC you will need to select 'Domestic – Permanently'. This will take you to the DTC submission page of TMS.

If you are releasing a player who is going on loan to another club, you will need to submit a loan transfer releasing the player.

To start a loan submission, once you have navigated to the Transfer Overview page of TMS, you will need to find the 'Engage Player' option at the top the screen and select it.



This will bring up a drop-down menu. For a DTC you will need to select 'Domestic – On Loan'. This will take you to the DTC submission page of TMS. For an ITC you will need to select 'International – On Loan'. This will take you to the ITC submission page of TMS.

RELEASE A PLAYER ON LOAN

Releasing a player permanently is the same process as submitting a normal ITC or DTC but with less steps.

For a DTC, you only need to complete the new player, new club sections. You will also need to select whether the player was 'amateur' or 'professional'. You will need to select 'professional' for this section. This will prompt you to put in the previous contract details, this is the contract that the player is on at your club. This date must match the dates in the loan transfer that was done by the new club for these to match in TMS.

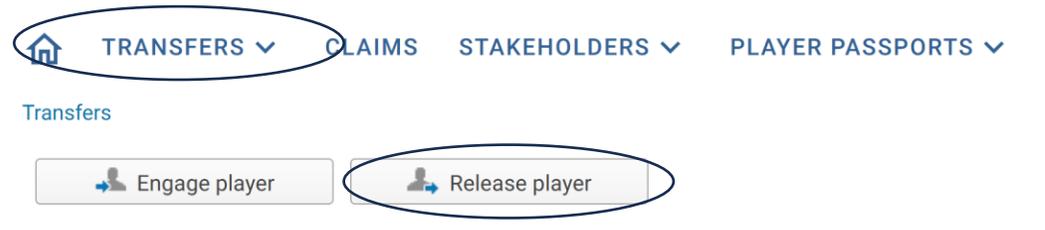

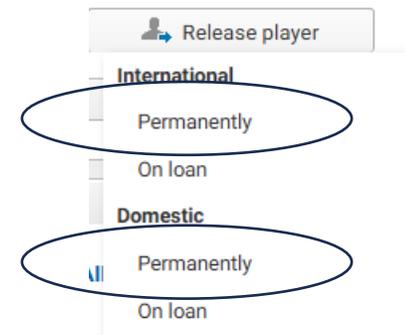
RELEASE A PLAYER UNDER A TRANSFER AGREEMENT

If you are releasing a player who is going to another club and you have signed a transfer agreement to release the player, you will need to submit a release – permanently transfer in TMS.

To start a release submission, once you have navigated to the Transfer Overview page of TMS, you will need to find the 'Engage Player' option at the top the screen and select it.



This will bring up a drop-down menu. For a DTC you will need to select 'Domestic – Permanently'. This will take you to the DTC submission page of TMS. For an ITC you will need to select 'International – Permanently'. This will take you to the ITC submission page of TMS.



TRANSFER AGREEMENTS

RELEASE A PLAYER UNDER A TRANSFER AGREEMENT

Releasing a player permanently is the same process as submitting a normal ITC or DTC but with less steps.



For an ITC or a DTC, you only need to complete the new player, new club sections. You will also need to select whether the player was 'amateur' or 'professional'. You will need to select 'professional' for this section. This will prompt you to put in the previous contract details, this is the contract that the player was on at your club, as well as the date of the transfer agreement. This date must match the dates in the transfer that was done by the new club for these to match in TMS.
